- If necessary, perform exercise stress tests, EKG's, or hook up Holter monitors in the absence of the stress or cardiac technician.
- Generate charge ticket, providing correct billing code, and making sure proper referrals or waiver signing has been done. Post charges into computer at the end of the day.
- Process echo reports: mail, fax, distribute reports and file. Copy requested studies to optical disc upon request in conjunction with Release of Information Department.
- Order all supplies for echo lab.
- Prepare statistical information for echoes performed.
- Work a schedule that may include nights and weekends to be determined by BMG Administration and/or Lab Director.
- Answer telephones and answer all questions regarding cardiac testing.
- Maintain equipment, address equipment representatives and train in equipment use and applications when needed.
